JOB DESCRIPTION

The faculty member in this position provides clinical supervision and instruction to graduate students of all levels in the Au.D. program; provides direct, billable client services to adult and pediatric populations in all areas of audiology; evaluates students according to ASHA guidelines and competencies; engages in scholarship; and provides service to the Department, College, and University.

PREFERRED SKILLS

These skills are not required, but preferred:

- Pediatric evaluation and treatment
- Pediatric and adult cochlear implant evaluation and mapping
- Pediatric and adult amplification
- Auditory processing disorder evaluation and intervention

EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED

- Supervise and instruct Au.D. graduate students during clinical experiences to ensure quality training
- Determine clinical direction and provide feedback of students' clinical performance
- Provide direct, billable client services in the USA Speech and Hearing Center, and complete required medical documentation/reports
