The United States Congress has recognized the value	ie of short-term academic exchange

The United States Congress has recognized the value of short-term academic exchanges by passing a law that permits international scholars entering the U.S. in "tourist" or "visitor" status to receive reimbursement for expenses and payments of honoraria. To qualify for the benefits of this law, your status and your activities must meet certain criteria.

To make it easier for you to meet the requirements for reimbursement and/or honorarium payment, we have prepared this simple assessment and declaration. **During your USA** visit your host department will help you complete the form and make copies of the identity and visa pages of your passport and of your Form I-94 (Arrival/Departure Record).

If English is *not* your first language and if you need help understanding any part of this letter or the form, your host department will arrange for someone to translate for you.

The basic requirements to qualify for reimbursement of expenses and payment of honoraria in visitor status are:

- 1. You must be present in the U.S. in visitor status as B-1, B-2, WB, or WT per the notation on your Form I-94. Canadians who cross the border without obtaining a Form I-94 are presumed to have been admitted in B-1/B-2 status.
- 2. The academic activities at USA for which you wish to receive reimbursement or honorarium must be no longer than 9 days.
- 3. During the six-month period immediately prior to your visit to USA you have accepted reimbursement from no more than five other institutions in the U.S. while in visitor status.

If you believe that you cannot meet one or more of these requirements, please contact your USA host department before you come to USA.

Your USA host department will help you complete the Declaration by Visitors Engaged in Academic Activities form after your arrival.
