## EXAMPLES OF PROJECTS THAT DO AND DO NOT REQUIRE IRB REVIEW

STUDIES THAT <u>ARE NOT</u> HUMAN SUBJECTS RESEARCH Studies that fit any of the categories below do not need IRB review.

- D**#**for internal departmental, school, or other University administrative purposes. Examples: teaching evaluations, customer service surveys.
- Sigissued or completed by University personnel for the intent and purposes of improving services and programs of the University or for developing new services

- Pbbebdob require IRB review. Examples: census data, labor statistics. • Note: Investigators should contact the IRB if they are uncertain as to whether the data qualifies as "publicly available". NOTE: IFACCESS UNITED NOT D b , IRB iasel
  - Contractions that were b collected for the currently proposed projects do not need IRB review as long as the investigator cannot link the coded data/specimens back to individual subjects. If the data/specimen provider has access to the identity of the subjects (e.g. subjects' names, addresses, etc.), the investigator must enter into an agreement with the data/specimen provider that states under n o circumstances will the identity of the subjects be released to the investigator.

Note: Investigators are not allowed to make this determination. These projects require verification from the IRB or the IRB liaison/designee. (
